

Health and Safety

Your health and safety is our concern as well as your own. We try to provide you with as safe a work environment as possible and, along with general training in safety procedures, have arranged for some special training in back care and food safety.

We have a Health and Safety Program that includes a formal Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee whose mandate is to review all workplace accidents, injuries and critical incidents for recommendations for prevention and correction. We provide you with information on Worker's Compensation and how to report an injury so your claim can be processed properly.

We also provide you with information on what to do if you are involved in a motor vehicle accident, whether driving for work or on your own time. In addition we provide you with some general information about communicable diseases and stress the importance of following Universal Precautions at all times in your daily routines. We have an Illness in the Workplace policy and Review Procedure in place to show our commitment to employees who have a serious illness and who may be facing a difficult time in their lives.

We are always looking for ways to improve our safety record so please contact us if you have any concerns or suggestions.
